**What Did They Wear Under There?**

Did you ever wonder how ladies' dresses held different shapes through the various eras? With 6 mannequins we will see how underpinnings shaped the dresses. Starting with the Elizabethan era and progressing to the late Victorian era, Quester presenter Linda Huerta will go layer by layer to divulge how the underwear framework shapes the dress.

Underpinnings not only helped to achieve the look (shape) of the period, but they protected the clothing from body oils and odors. Linda, who has pursued historic costuming for 23 years, has sewn garments and undergarments from the 1818 Regency Empire era to 1830s Regency, 1860s-1890s Victorian eras and 1910 Edwardian.
